Job Duties

- 1. Follow all established health and safety procedures as developed by Alta Mons.
- 2. Cabin counselor, reside with the unit and supervise all aspects of the campers' day.
- 3. Take an interest in and learn about each camper.
- 4. Facilitate camper and staff relationships with each other, God, and Creation. Be open and receptive to camper questions about faith and guide campers as they grow in their own personal faith.
- 5. Provide and monitor unit activities in ways that allow each camper to experience the community and the success of the group.
- 6. Guide unit and individual campers in participating successfully in all aspects of challenge/adventure activities.
- 7. Work directly with co-counselor to manage conflict, plan activities, and communicate effectively.
- 8. Assist in outdoor living skills by instruction and example, including: hiking, open fire cooking, low-impact camping, canoeing, etc. Specific activities will depend on the age group you are assigned to work with.
- 9. Be present for all meetings, unit activities and debriefing sessions.
- 10. Assist and help in all other duties as assigned.
