There are 2 locations available for RV camping, the Wetlands (24 sites plus 1 pop up site) and the Riverside (13 sites). The Wetlands is alongside Purgatory Creek and is close to a bath house with showers and toilets. The Riverside has a communal RV shelter, communal fire pit and a central dump station. Each individual site has electric hook-up (30 amp and 20 amp), water hook-up, a picnic table and a fire pit.

There are 7 tent sites. Each tent site comes with a picnic table and fire pit. There is a communal water spigot, porta john, and bathhouse nearby.

Shelter 3, located near the Wetlands area, contains 16 picnic benches and a large charcoal grill. It has electrical outlets and is surrounded by field space.

Shelter 4, located by the camp office and pole course, contains 8 picnic tables. It has electrical outlets and lights. It is surrounded by field space.
