Job Duties

- 1. Follow all established health and safety procedures as developed by Alta Mons.
- 2. To support the vision and mission of the Camp Alta Mons Summer Camp Ministry.
- 3. To safely drive the camp van during all summer camp outings. This includes staff outings and camper outings.
- 4. To serve as a co-staff facilitator to the Ropes Coordinator. The Trips Coordinator will attend ropes training and work on the ropes course with the Ropes Coordinator.
- 5. To inventory and take care of adventure equipment before, during, and after camp. This includes tents, duffle bags, sleeping pads, tarps, and twine.
- 6. To serve as a support and role model for the counselors, CITs, and campers.
- 7. To provide support to counselors in breaks, games, and in other ways as needed by the Program Coordinators.
- 8. The Trips Coordinator will be required to attend ropes training, van driver training, coordinator training, staff training, all of summer camp, and coordinator wrap-up after summer camp. Please see the website for dates.
- 9. Provide assistance to the Program Coordinators, as needed, to help camp run smoothly.
- 10. Assist and help in all other duties as assigned.
