The Riverside has a communal RV shelter, communal fire pit and a central dump station. Each individual site has electric hook-up, 30 amp and 20 amp, water hook-up, picnic table and a fire pit.

There are 7 tent sites. Each tent site comes with a picnic table and fire pit. There is a communal water spigot, porta john, and bathhouse nearby.
